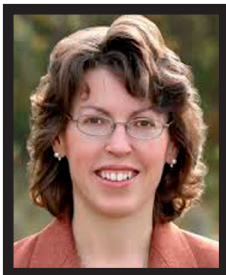

# Celebrating the Scranton Conference's 37<sup>th</sup> year serving the Church

## **“Charismatic Renewal is a current of grace, a renewing breath of the Spirit for all members of the Church”** Pope Francis

**Dr. Mary Healy**, professor of Scripture at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit, is a bestselling author and international speaker. She is a general editor of the Catholic Commentary on Sacred Scripture and author of two of its volumes, The Gospel of Mark and Hebrews. Her other books include The Spiritual Gifts Handbook and Healing: Bringing the Gift of God's Mercy to the World. Dr. Healy serves as chair of the Doctrinal Commission of CHARIS in Rome. She was appointed by Pope Francis as one of the first three women ever to serve on the Pontifical Biblical Commission.

**Patrick Reis** is the Director of Encounter Ministries and host of the EWTN globally syndicated Encounter Radio. He has a passion and drive to see Catholics empowered to walk in the power and love of the Holy Spirit. Patrick carries a strong heart for seeing Christian unity made manifest and speaks at conferences internationally. He was recently featured in “Fearless” a documentary on the Holy Spirit and Evangelization. Patrick received his Bachelor's degree from Franciscan University of Steubenville and his Master's degree from Holy Apostles College & Seminary and has previously been in full-time ministry at Immaculate Heart of Mary Catholic Church, Cincinnati, and St. Patrick Catholic Church, Columbus.

**Bob Valiante** Bob and Sue Valiante have been married for fifty-six years; they are parents of one child, Maria. The Valiantes live in Moosic, Pa. Bob has been involved in the Charismatic Renewal of the Catholic Church for forty-seven years. In that time, he has served in various capacities. He is a past coordinator of the Service Team for the Catholic Charismatic Renewal of the Diocese of Scranton, a founder and former coordinator of the annual Catholic Charismatic Conference of the Diocese of Scranton, which is in its thirty seventh year. Bob served as Pastoral Associate in his parish for seven years. A frequent speaker at days of renewal, conferences, retreats, parish missions, and regional gatherings; Bob shares his gift of exhortation. He is the Liaison to the Bishop and Coordinator of the Charismatic Renewal for the Diocese of Scranton, and a former member of the Service Committee of the Association of Diocesan Liaisons.

**Fr. Raymond Francis** is a Parish Priest of the Toco/Matelot Cluster in the Archdiocese of Port of Spain. The founder of the lay young adults' Charismatic Missionary group, “Trinitarian Presence Missionaries,” he was graduated from the Regional Seminary, Mount St. Benedict Trinidad via the University of the West Indies. He has been involved in the Charismatic Renewal in the Archdiocese Port of Spain for over 30 years, and also involved in service team, conferences, rallies, and other renewal events. He has been involved in the School of Evangelization as a teacher trainer and has walked the streets of communities both locally and regionally bringing the Gospel message to thousands of people. Father Francis lived in the “Eternal Light Community” a Lay Charismatic Community for a number of years, serving as youth coordinator. He has conducted Life in the Spirit Seminars throughout Trinidad and Tobago, is a speaker always in heavy demand both locally and regionally; and he has a special healing and deliverance Ministry, through the Blessed Sacrament for many years. His ministry that has taken him to many of the Islands in the Caribbean and to the United States as a gifted speaker and revivalist who often blends music and song in his presentations.
